

General Guidelines For all Permit Types

Refer to handouts for specific construction project for detailed information BUILDING PERMITS

- 1. Two sets of complete construction plans. One set will be returned with comments/corrections.
- 2. Two sets of the proposed grading plan/survey. See grading plan handout for requirements. Include the building setbacks on the grading plan/survey.
- 3. Submit a copy of the HOA/Architectural Review Board approval if applicable.
- 4. Building permit applications must be signed and filled out completely. Any pertinent information that is not filled in will cause the application to be rejected.
- 5. Copy of current Minnesota contractor's license.
- 6. Copy of current EPA Lead Certificate.
- 7. When the building permit is ready to be picked up, we will contact you.
- 8. The Building permit, inspection sign off card and the City approved plans must be posted on the job site.
- 9. All construction sites must have the house number clearly marked from the start of construction. This is an emergency response safety requirement.

MECHANICAL - HVAC - PERMITS

A complete and signed Mechanical application and a City Contractor's License are required.

PLUMBING PERMITS

A complete and signed Plumbing application and a copy of current State Plumbing Contractor's License are required.

SEWER & WATER PERMITS

A complete and signed Plumbing permit application and a City Contractor's License are required.

ELECTRICAL PERMITS

Stillwater does not process electrical permits or perform electrical inspections.
