


MONTHLY REPORT

Training

During April, SFD trained in excess of 500 hours. Training hours increased due to the fact that four probationary staff completed their initial hazardous materials training. Other training included wildland firefighting, extrication and power tools, EMS, ladders, ropes and knots, rappelling and ropes, The Minnesota Firefighter Initiative (MnFIRE) offered an in house seminar on cardiac, cancer and emotional wellness.
