



Stillwater Fire Department Monthly Report February 2019

ACTIVITY REPORT:

The month of February was busy for Stillwater Fire Department. Members responded to 171 calls for service. The chart below is a break down of the services provided.







TRAINING:

SFD personnel train on a weekly basis. In February, personnel trained for a minimum of 146 hours and some of the training included Mayday Search and Rescue, Rapid Intervention Team Training, Dive Training, Firefighter Wellness, OSHA and Driver Training.
