



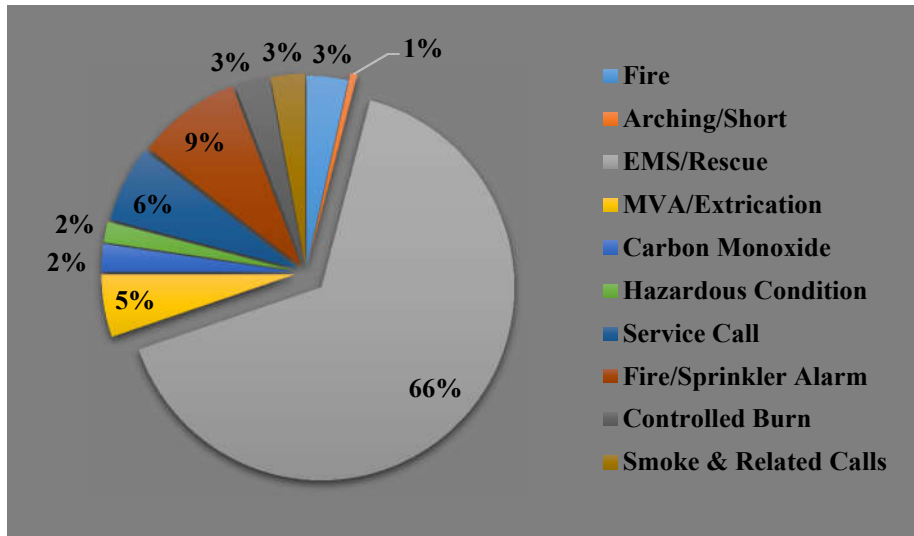
# Stillwater Fire Department

#### ACTIVITY REPORT:

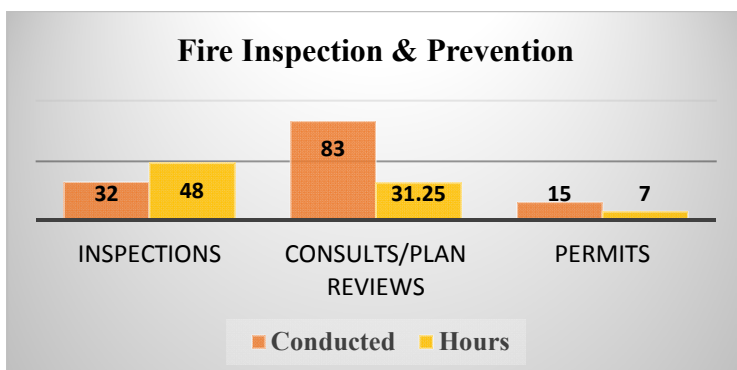
During the month of January, SFD responded to 172 calls. The breakdown of the services provided is as follows:



#### Training

SFD personnel train monthly. In January staff members trained 310 hours. Training included:

- Distracted Driving for Emergency Vehicle Operators
- Dive Training
- Bloodborne Pathogens Safety
- Lock Out/Tag Out
- Hazard Communication
- EMS
- AED / CPR
- Advanced Hazardous Material Training
- Fire Department Communications
- Portable Extinguishers

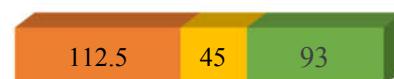
