



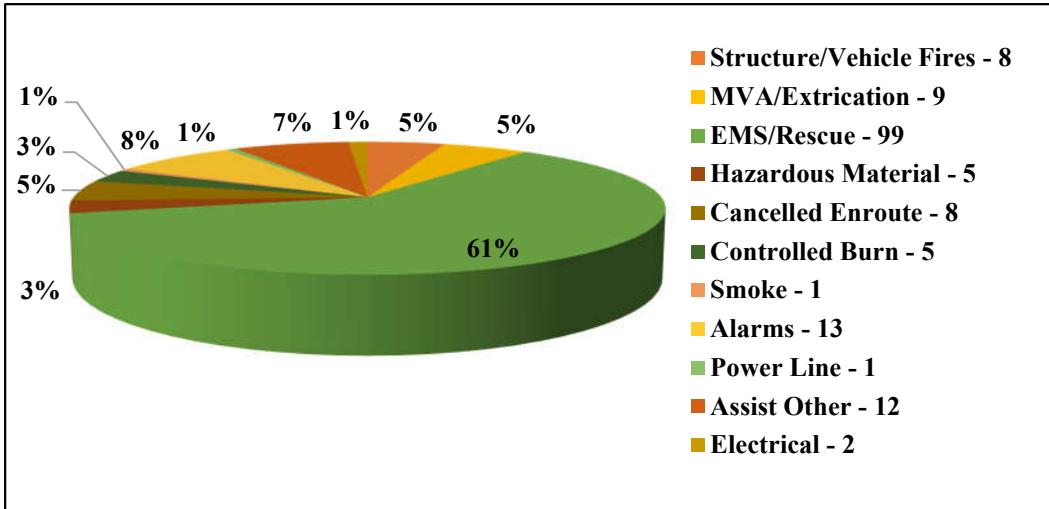

ACTIVITY REPORT:

During March, the Stillwater Fire Department responded to **163** calls for service. The chart below is a breakdown of the services provided.



Incident Type by Number of Incidents

- Fire - 8
- MVA/Extrication - 9
- Hazardous Material - 5
- Alarms - 13
- Electrical - 2
- Cancelled Enroute - 8
- Controlled Burn - 6
- Assist Other - 12
- EMS - 99

163 calls and 28 were overlapping - 17% of the call volume

2019 Spring Flood Operations

SFD was involved in maintaining the safety of businesses conducting preplan flood preparation inspections and scene safety at sandbagging which took place over nine days for a total of **159 hours**.

Training

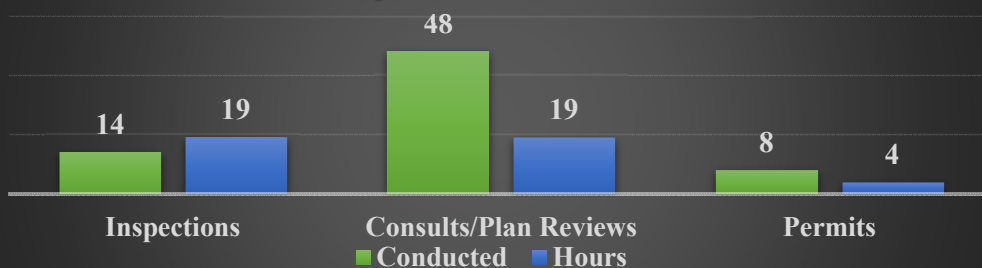
