

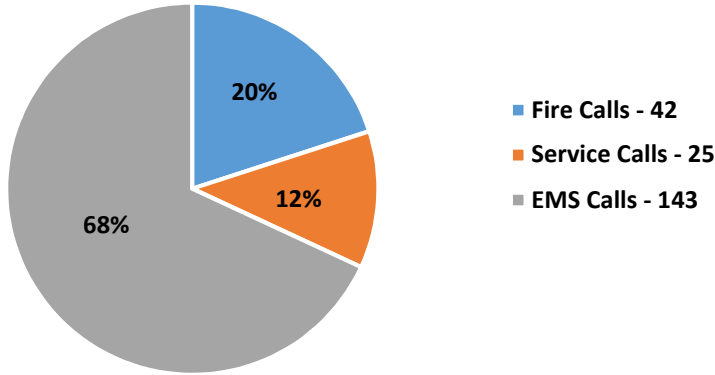

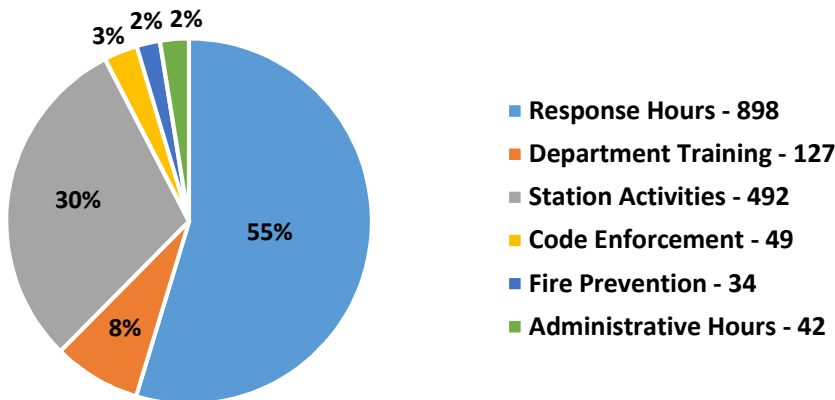

### Simple steps to prevent a CO incident:

Clear snow from outdoor furnace, dryer, fireplace or other vents  
Test CO alarms to ensure they are working properly  
A CO alarm should be on each level of a home and within 10 feet of sleeping areas
