

Adopt-a-Drain Program

Help eliminate pollution from entering our lakes streams and rivers. A new program, **Adopt a Drain**, asks residents to adopt a drain in their neighborhood and commit to keeping it clear of leaves and other debris to reduce water pollution. All it takes is fifteen minutes, twice a month, for cleaner waterways and healthier communities

Sign up is easy! Go to Adopt-a-Drain.org, enter your address and choose a drain near your house. Once you've adopted your drain, keep it clean by sweeping and raking up the debris off the drain surface year round. .Keep an estimated total of the debris you collect and enter it into your online account so we can gauge the cumulative results of our work.

Let friends and neighbors know about your commitment and, if they ask, tell them about small things they can do at home to prevent water pollution.
